Capacity

After 3 years as a sole trader Thomas started trading as TCS Shipwright & Joinery in February 2013, and now operates a twenty-man plus operation. Retaining such a large team, including qualified tradesman across different disciplines, allows us to tackle large projects with staff that are trained and experienced. We place a strong focus on investing in our staff and equipment to bring to market the skills and equipment needed to service buyer needs. We have developed a team with diverse and specialist skills sets, including various high risk works, and continue to train our own staff in many areas. We strive for a positive culture of collaboration and enthusiasm within our team, and enjoy seeing the pride our staff take in their work.

Fully Equipped Workshop

We have invested in quality SCM Italian tooling, upgrading all our large tools in 2016. We have multiple spray booths, and all manner of specialist power and hand tools. In early 2018 we installed a fully enclosed blast room and have invested in our workforce employing fully qualified and experienced tradespeople to provide high spec refurbishment of metal components. We have the capacity to fabricate many components in house, and invite you to visit our workshop to gain an understanding of our capabilities.

TCS Shipwright & Joinery carries Ship Repairer's Liability, Public Liability and Worker's Compensation Insurances. We have understanding and experience of Government contract compliance, including relevant work, safety, and quality reporting, and sourcing of materials that meet Navy specifications. Long term and key staff who have been working with Thomas since his sole trader days, now have nigh on a decade of experience working on many of the Navy Vessels currently maintained in Cairns, including ever evolving contractual requirements. With a dedicated OHSE QA manager, who has come to our company after serving in the RAN, we ensure that compliance to specifications and procedures is of top consideration when tendering for, offering advice, and reporting on Navy or Government works.

Building upon the many years Thomas and Steve had under their belt working on Cairns based vessels, TCS Shipwright & Joinery as a company has carried out multiple maintenance periods on Navy Vessels since commencing trade in 2013. We have a proven track record of delivering works on time and to the satisfaction of the Tier One contractor. We have tackled many areas of Navy Vessel maintenance including:

- Custom joinery for bridge and electrical equipment (dashes and consoles)

- Coldroom refurbishment / reconfiguration / replacement
