We continue to train our own staff, and strive for reliable relationships with industry colleagues to ensure we can produce works to a high standard across a wide variety of project aspects. Fully Equipped Workshop

We have invested in quality SCM Italian tooling, upgrading all our large tools in 2016. We have also have multiple spray booths and all manner of specialist power and hand tools. In early 2018 we installed a fully enclosed blast room and have invested in our workforce employing fully qualified and experienced tradespeople to provide high spec refurbishment of metal components. We have the capacity to fabricate many components in house, and invite you to visit our workshop to gain an understanding of our capabilities.
